Evaluate your operational network against the 5 Andean Principles of Extreme-Biome Adaptation.

[] 1. Edge Node Decentralization (The Tambo Test)

- Do we rely on a single central warehouse that a severe weather event could paralyze?
- Do we have localized, pre-audited inventory nodes near high-risk delivery zones?

[] 2. Biome-Specific Transit (The Adaptability Test)

- Are we forcing a standardized transit protocol across completely different environmental zones?
- Are our packaging and vehicle specs calibrated to hyper-local weather data?

[] 3. Resource Sovereignty (The Hydrology Test)

- Have we secured primary access to the foundational resources (water, power, minerals) required for local operations?

[] 4. Ecological Quota Alignment (The Yield Test)

- Are our extraction/production goals tied to fixed corporate targets or real-time local ecological yields?

[] 5. Localized Compliance Alliances (The Kuraka Test)

- Are we managing extreme-environment operations entirely from a distant HQ?
- Do we have binding, mutually beneficial joint ventures with local operators on the ground?
